The **WHHO** was founded in 1984 with a mission to preserve and improve the quality of life in Woodland Hills and surrounding areas.

WHHO is a member of Woodland Hills Chamber of Commerce.

WHHO was instrumental in the acquisition of over 400 acres to be add to Topanga State Park which made access from the Valley possible. These included the Avitar and 21000 Mulholland properties.
